# The Token Tech \#2000™ High Security Token Dispenser 



Dimensions of the Dispenser are approx. $8 \times 12 \times 18$ inches. Weight is about 135 lbs., fully loaded with tokens. Dispenser housing is heavy gauge steel, with hard acrylic Computer Grey finish.

Note: The 220 Volt Model has a built-in Transformer which accounts for the difference in weight.

When ordering, Customer should specify Token Size, Control Token Number, or send samples of Tokens or Coins which will be used in Dispenser.

The Token Tech \#2000™ is a well proven, highsecurity token dispenser, representing the ultimate in control, accuracy, security and dispensing reliability. It offers push-button operation, with built-in memory, and fail-safe, hardened circuitry. It features a pre-dispense LED display, with an automatic error re-set control button. Operation is standard 110 Volt power. ( 220 Volt Models built to order).

The dispenser is a two-key, double-lock system, with a non-resettable counter. Vended token readings (totals) can be taken on a daily, hourly, or work shift basis. The dispenser is designed to be completely pilfer proof, and theft proof. It has the option of being bolted to a counter or wall, if desired.

The Token Tech \#2000™ comes with a 10-foot remote control unit, which can be either hand-held, or mounted on or near a cash register, for more convenient use.

Hopper capacity is from 6,000 to 10,000 tokens, depending on token size. It can be used with a wide range of tokens, including all of those now in use.

Each dispenser has a display frame ready for you to insert your own Display Sign. Easily printed on your desktop printer, the dimensions are... Width $=7.87^{\prime \prime}$ $(200 \mathrm{~mm})$, Height $=8.97$ " $(228 \mathrm{~mm})$. We suggest black ink on medium weight card stock. Clear plastic laminating will keep your sign clean and new-looking for years.

## Simplified Control Operation

The Operator's Control Panel has been designed for accurate and simple use. There are only Six Instruction Buttons:


Pulses from each Count Button add to the total on the Bright Red LED Digital Display. The operator reads the total displayed, to confirm and verify that total is correct. If total is correct, the operator then pulses the VEND Start Dispense Button.

If total is incorrect, the operator pushes the RESET Reset Count Button, which clears the LED Display to zero. He then pushes the Count Buttons, for a correct total, before pushing the VEND Start Dispense Button.

## Special Note

The Token Tech \#2000 should not be considered for use with Aluminum or Plastic Coins or Tokens.

Tokens with grooves, or with irregular shapes will cause problems and are not suitable to use with the Token Tech.

## Routine Replacement Parts \& Components

For Token Techs in use beyond the Standard Warranty period of one year, or for extra Remote Controls, etc., we keep an inventory of such items, usually available for immediate shipment. Please advise the Serial Number of your Dispenser.

## Dispensing Coins

The Token Tech \#2000 can be used to dispense Coins. Any Coin within the range of 20.32 mm to 28.57 mm diameter ( .800 to 1.125 inches) is possible. This should be specified when ordering.

In many Countries, it is not possible to use "Bill Changers" because of the size and variations of the Currency in that Country, and/or due to the fact that Currency Validators (Readers) have not been developed or perfected for the Currency (Paper Money) of the Country involved.

Dispensing Coins is one of the reasons for the New Encode Button Options for the Remote Control.

## Warranties and Guarantees

The Token Tech \#2000 is offered with a 30-day return guarantee, with full refund, excluding shipping charges. If you are not completely satisfied, for any reason, you may return your trial order. Returns under this guarantee must be authorized with prior written notice and approval, and with shipping charges prepaid. Returns must be securely packaged for safe transit, and fully insured. Damaged returns will not be accepted under this guarantee.
The Token Tech \#2000 is sold with a one-year warranty from date of shipment, against any defects in workmanship or serviceability. ## Token Tech \#2000™ Dispenser: Standard Features \& New Options



These two illustrations show the rear view of

the Token Tech Housing. At the lower back of the unit, you see:
(A) The Primary Counter with Viewing Lens. This Counter has 6 Digits, and is NONThis Counter has 6 Digits, and is NON-
RESETTABLE. The daily "Start Count" is recorded, and is subtracted from the "Ending Count". The difference is the total Tokens dispensed.
(B) Connector Port for Remote Control Cable.
(C) The "On-Off" Switch.
(D) Power Supply Cord with Safety Strain Relief.

These two illustrations show the New \& Optional Manager's Second Counter. It is accessible Only when the Manager opens the Security Cover to load additional Tokens. This is a 5-Digit Counter, and is PUSH BUTTON ReSETTABLE to zero (00000).


The Manager's Second Counter is positioned under the Safety Feed Ramp, and does not interfere with the Token feed to the Rotary Hopper.


Both Counters are pulsed when dispensing, and both register a Continuous Count. The Manager's Second Counter eliminates the need of subtracting a 6-Digit (Starting Count) Number from a 6-Digit (Day's Count.



The Standard Remote Control has Input Buttons 1-4-20-40-Reset-Vend. You can easily get to ANY desired Dispense Count. The Bright Red Display starts with "0" and increases with each Button pushed.

> To dispense 9 Tokens, you would push 4+4+1. For 25 Tokens, $20+4+1$.

If you make a mistake, and the Display is incorrect, then you push the "Reset" Button which returns the Display to "0".

When the Display reads the desired Dispense Count, push the "Vend" button, and the Dispenser proceeds with the dispensing operation.

## Large Hopper Capacity

When filled to capacity, the Token Dispenser weighs about 135 pounds. Capacity depends on size of Token, as shown below. For sizes other than those listed, Dispensers can be built to order. Quotation on request.

## Non-Resettable Counter

Any total desired can be counted and vended. The TOTAL VENDED COUNTER is completely tamper-proof and NON-RESETTABLE. Hourly, daily, work-shift, etc., readings can be taken, for Total Tokens Vended in that time interval. The total is determined by subtracting the previous reading from the current reading.

It is a good idea to keep an on-going Managers Log Book or Diary for these records. Also, some managers insist that both he and the employee read the totals, and the employee is often asked to sign or initial his confirmation of correct readings. This is recommended especially when high-value Tokens are involved.

## Lock-Out Feature

Dispenser cannot be operated unless Manager's Key is inserted and turned to the ON Position. In the event of a power failure, or mechanical malfunction, the Dispenser automatically shuts down. If there is a power outage during a vend countdown cycle, the Dispenser remembers the balance due the customer.

## Countdown \& Memory Features

The LED Digital Display shows the "countdown" as the hopper is dispensing Tokens. Hopper payout is fast, and without interruption. If there is a hopper run-out during a vend mode, the balance due count shows on the Display. Let's say, for example, that you are in the process of

vending 20 Game Tokens for your customer's $\$ 5.00$ bill. The Dispenser stops vending at 16 Tokens, because the hopper is empty. The Display will read " 4 " as the balance due. The memory circuit remembers this balance until it is paid out, or until the Reset Button is pushed, clearing the Count Circuit.

Arcade Tokens are valued at 25c.
